Durham Region, ON -- It was a great day in Durham Region, where SuperWalk has never been rained on.

On Sunday, September 27, the Durham Region Chapter of Parkinson Society Canada held its annual fundraising SuperWalk for Parkinson's. Last year's 122 walkers, up to walk day, brought in \$52,700. This year's organizing committee hoped to achieve \$60,000.

It turns out that this year's 157 walkers brought in \$72,500 up to walk day. The committee are very pleased to say the least. Factoring in the generosity of corporate sponsors, which covers all walk expenses, plus after-walk donor money, total walk revenue was about \$78,000.

One team of walkers, called Raising the Roof for Parkinson's, raised over \$10,000. The top three individual walkers together raised over \$18000. They are former-MP George Ashe, Leslee Wills, and Jean Keary, the head of the local SuperWalk organizing committee. Thank you goes to all walkers, donors, corporate sponsors, and volunteers.

Funds raised by SuperWalk go the national organization to help pay for research into finding a cure and easing the burden of Parkinson's disease.
